Pregnancy tests, education on baby's development, ultrasounds, options information, preparation for parenting or placing for adoption, mommy & baby clothing & items, & education on godly sexuality. We offer the Gospel to each client & area churches.

Why do a Baby Bottle Fundraiser?

The Baby Bottle Fundraiser (BBF) is a wonderful mission project that allows you, your family (kids can earn money doing chores), your church or group to impact new parents-to-be with LIFE and Jesus! Financial support literally means LIFE to little ones, whose parents have come to the Center! We are so thankful that you're thinking of hosting a Baby Bottle Fundraiser!

Choose the tools & methods that work best for your church/group & that your leadership approves of.



BBF Kit Tools:

- ◆ Baby Bottles with tags
- ◆ Flyers/Bulletin inserts
Make a Difference Flyers! Or
Mother's Day / Father's Day Flyers
Baby Bottle Collection Next Week!
- ◆ Posters - Hang on Bulletin Boards or around the Church.
- ◆ Video to use at Kick-off (1.50 Min).
- ◆ Collection reminder signs

How to do a Baby Bottle Fundraiser

- ◆ Get permission from your pastor /leader & decide which tools you'll use
- ◆ Ask children, youth, classes to take part.
- ◆ Choose kick-off date & collection date 2-4 weeks (1 month is best)
- ◆ Pick up the customized BBF Kit from the center near you
- ◆ Place posters in good places
- ◆ Ask pastor/leader to promote the BBF
- ◆ Set up display table near exit with bottles where people pass by. Pass out bottles in an active but way but be sensitive.
- ◆ Prepare your fliers/posters with collection date
- ◆ Ask the Grace House Mission speaker to share at kick-off
- ◆ OR you or your leader share about our mission

On Distribution Day

- ◆ Put prepared fliers in bulletins or lay out for pick up
 - ◆ Have a looping screen shot,
 - ◆ Pastor's show of support is key!
 - ◆ Show DVD and/or
 - ◆ Make announcement during service and/or meeting & share how they can participate:
1. Take a Baby Bottle
 2. Fill it with Change, Cash or Check
 3. Fill out the tag to receive a tax receipt letter & list your church/group's name
 4. Return Bottle on collection day

If you are speaking, share statistics of those we've served.

Explain how we are serving people spiritually with a story of a heart change and/or a saved or changed life.

*use newsletter/letter, or ask us for a story

Contact us to get more info or help!

Each week during your event have:

- ◆ Weekly reminders on the screens
- ◆ Bulletin announcements
- ◆ Encouragement from pastor/leader
- ◆ Collect bottles brought in & store in a secure place or bring filled bottles to Grace House each week.

One week before Collection Date

- ◆ Put reminder in bulletin with collection date on it.
- ◆ Give collection day reminder to bring bottles next week. Tell them where to put the filled bottles.

We have a crate & dolly system you can use as these can be HEAVY!

On Collection Day

Collect bottles and thank those who are turning them in. Make sure that they have filled out tag so they get a tax receipt/letter. It's great if church/group name is on the tags for recording. Have someone stand near bottles collected until they are secured.

1 week after Collection Day

Give reminders for bottles (filled or empty) to be turned in for those who've forgotten. After this, either ask people to bring bottles directly to us, or let them continue to come in, secure them, & bring them to us as you're able to. If you need help, ask us to pick them up!

Return Bottles to Grace House

You don't need to count or roll the money in the bottles. We have volunteers to record it all & a machine at our bank that counts it all for free! We will send each person a receipt/letter. We will also send the church/group a total of the amount collected. There are many churches participating and there is a light hearted competition to see who gives the most money during the year. Those winning Churches will be awarded at our Annual Gala in April.
